◆ PROVISIONAL AUDIOLOGY LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:

- Master's Degree in an Audiology program
- 400 clinical practicum hours if graduate program began after January 1, 2004
- Passing score on Praxis examination or ASHA certification

****The Provisional Audiology license may only be held for a period of three years.****

Submit to the Board:

- Notarized Application
- \$125.00 application fee paid by certified check, cashier's check or money order.
- Official transcript sent directly to the board from one or more regionally accredited colleges or universities stating "Degree Awarded"
- Breakdown of clinical practicum hours signed by a clinical supervisor or director
- Official passing score on Praxis examination or copy of ASHA Certified Member card
- If applicable, Verification of Licensure from any state licensure has previously been held.
