◆ **PROVISIONAL SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY ASSISTANT LICENSE REQUIREMENTS:**

- Bachelor's Degree in a speech-language pathology program
- 100 clinical practicum hours
Must be obtained through a regionally accredited educational institution or its cooperating programs. Of the 100, 75 shall be obtained with direct patient/client contact with a minimum of 20 hours in speech disorders, a minimum of 20 hours in language disorders, and the remaining 35 hours may be obtained in the areas of speech, language or hearing disorders. The remaining 25 hours may be obtained through observation of testing and therapy.

Submit to the Board:

- Notarized Application
- \$125.00 application fee paid by certified check, cashier's check or money order.
- Official transcript sent directly to the board from one or more regionally accredited colleges or universities stating "Degree Awarded"
- Breakdown of clinical practicum hours signed by a clinical supervisor or director
- If applicable, Verification of Licensure from any state licensure has previously been held.

****The Provisional Speech-Language Pathology license may only be held for a period of three years.****
