ASHA accepts, without pre-approval, professional development workshops sponsored by professional associations and organizations, colleges/universities, etc.**	LBESPA accepts workshops directly in the area of communication disorders sponsored by professional associations and organizations and several other activities without pre- approval.

* Activities which are within the Scope of Practice in Audiology or the Scope of Practice in Speech-Language Pathology must be selected. The Clinical Certification (maintenance) Standards give the certificate holder the responsibility to select professional development activities which result in the acquisition of new knowledge and skills, or the enhancement of current knowledge and skills necessary for independent practice of any area of the professions and in any practice setting. Professional development activities are further defined as: activities in which the content is related to the science or contemporary practice of audiology, speech-language pathology, or the speech/language/hearing sciences; the knowledge and skills learned are appropriate, relevant and meaningful to any area of practice and practice setting; and the certificate holder's attendance can be documented by a third party (e.g., employer, sponsoring organization). **Pre-approval is not required for the purpose of maintaining the CCC's. Only ASHA CEUs will be maintained on the ASHA CE Registry; all other activities must be documented by the individual certificate holder and must include a certificate of attendance/completion (or copy of college transcript)/supporting documentation that confirms the title of the activity, name of the sponsor for the activity, name of the participant, date and number of contact hours, etc. Activity content must meet the ASHA Clinical Certification Standards definition of professional development.
